Note:

- To provide a stable power supply, kindly use the cable provided with the product and connect to a AC 230V 50/60Hz power source.
- Avoid the self-disassembly of the product as it results in voiding of the product's warranty.
- Avoid looking directly at the projector lens while it is active.
- Make sure that the projector's air vents are not blocked while in use. The device must be kept in a well ventilated surrounding for proper functioning.
- It is recommended to power OFF the projector after a continuous usage of 6 hours maximum.
- Place the projector away from water or other liquids. Avoid water accumulation and ensure good ventilation.



Remote Control




NOTE:


- 1. To avoid power shortage, please do not mix and use the old and new battery.
- 2. To avoid battery leakage corrosion, if do not use remote control for a long time, please take the battery out.

Setting Up the Projector

1. Connect the power cable to the socket and the cord to the projector and turn it ON.




- 2. Before turning ON, make sure to place it in a flat surface for a proper projection then Press the power button / turn it on by using the remote
- 3. Align the projector as shown in the image below to ensure proper projection.



Projector distance & size

The recommended projection screen size is 102 - 305 cm. To improve your viewing experience, ensure you have a room where you can control the lighting. These factors work together to provide a visually stunning and immersive viewing experience.




Note:

Due to optical device variation of about 3%, the above data is for reference only.

Focus Adjustment

Note: There is no manual focus, it has only electronic focus. Do not rotate the lens or it will be damaged.



By default, the auto focus is enabled, allowing it to quickly detect and adjust to the optimal clarity of the screen, or you can adjust the picture clarity using the remote.

Keystone Adjustments

The projector will auto keystone to 4-points, or you can manually adjust under settings



Android Home

- 1. Once the projector is turned on you'll be directed to the home screen.
- 2. The Home screen displays Apps, Playstore, Settings Menu, File Manager, Input Source HDMI, etc.




Open the homepage, select settings main menu found in the last section of the homepage.

Network settings, Bluetooth settings, projection settings, language settings, date settings, application settings, system update, other settings.



HDMI Connection

Connecting Your Projector with a Cable



Once the HDMI interface is connected to the projector, you will need to select the specific signal source as the input. After connected the content played on the source will be streamed on the projector.

Bluetooth Setting

- A. Blutooth Setting
- 1. Go to(Settings) > (Bluetooth Setting)
- 2. Turn the Bluetooth Connection on and search for nearby Bluetooth devices.
- 3. Choose correct Bluetooth device to connect

NOTE:

I. Due to compatibility issues with the Bluetooth protocol, some brands of Bluetooth speakers may not support connection to our projectors. If you have such an issue, feel free to let us know.

B. As a Bluetooth Speaker

Navigate to <u>Speaker Mode</u>, on the home screen and the projector can be used as a Bluetooth Speaker.



Screen Mirroring:

Connect your iOS, Android, Laptop, or Tablet wirelessly via the device mirroring option. Local photos and videos support Screen Mirroring.

NOTE:

Please ensure the projector and your device have been connected to the same Wi-Fi; if there is no Wi-Fi, please open a hotspot on your device and connect the projector.
